

TERMS & CONDITIONS EVENTS 2020

Upon signing up for this event you declare that:

Article 1. Horses

- **1.1** You are aware that activities involving horses can be dangerous and unpredictable and that you can be injured or killed. You accept all risks of personal injury, death or property damage (including to or by your horse) to yourself or caused to others.
- **1.2** You hold third party liability insurance, or accept that you may be held personally responsible for injury or damage to the horses, people or property that is caused by yourself.

Article 2. Rider requirements

- **2.1** Riders must wear a BS approved helmet at all times when mounted. Helmets must comply with BS EN0384 or PAS015, be less than 5 years old from the date of manufacture, have not suffered a significant impact, and must have the chinstrap fastened.
- **2.2** Appropriate riding shoes or boots must be worn at all times when mounted. Basic equipment of a cavesson, rein and dressage whip will be provided. Riders do need to make sure to bring a fitting riding helmet and proper riding outfit incl. riding boots/shoes

Article 3. Payments

- **3.1** By signing up for this event and upon purchasing a ticket, the participant agrees with his/her obligation to pay for the course.
- **3.2** It is the responsibility of the participant that the fee will be paid before the clinic starts. If the payment hasn't been received before the first day of the clinic, Classical Horse Training is

entitled to exclude the participant from partaking. This does not suspend the participant's obligation to pay.

Article 4. Cancellation policy

- **4.1** There will be no refund given upon any cancellation on behalf of the participant. However, if the participant can find a suitable replacement for taking over the spot or there is a waiting list, the fee will be refunded within 10 working days.
- **4.2** Upon the unlikely cancellation of the event by the organizer, a full refund of the participation fee will be given within 14 days. Any additional costs such as overnight stays, flights, conversion or transfers costs will not be refunded.

You are strongly advised to close on a cancellation insurance.

Article 5. Photo/Video

- **5.1** During the lessons it's not allowed to take pictures or to record with a video camera for spectators. Riders are allowed to film their own lessons for private use. It's not allowed to put the recordings on YouTube or any other internet platforms.
- **5.2**. Any official pictures taken by Classical Horse Training will be send afterwards and can be used for social media free of use. Classical Horse Training is entitled to use any material for marketing purposes unless the participant/spectator clearly states written objection beforehand in which case Classical Horse Training will honor the objections.

Article 6. Liability Release

By signing up to this event you emphatically declare to:

- **6.1** Agree to the financial obligation
- **6.2** To have fully read and understood the terms and conditions on this form and are aware that this forms an agreement between yourself and Classical Horse Training (Thirza Hendriks, kvk: 62268597).
- **6.3** You also understand that the organizers/instructors and location of hire cannot be held liable for any physical and material damage which is a direct or indirect result and/or a consequent of an accident during, before and after the event in question. This exclusion of liability covers/includes damage to your horse, participants/students and their horse, third parties and their horse, objects or building.
